Did you know that you must comply with Unique Device Identification (UDI) regulations for overseas trading of medical devices?

Great News! GS1 is recognised as an Accredited Unique Device Identification (UDI) Issuing Agency for the identification of Medical Devices and is also the global identifier of choice for Pharmaceuticals!

By supporting GS1 Standards and Keys for medical products identification, we help you to ensure compliance with global healthcare regulations.

Global Adoption of GS1 Standards

- A. **US FDA**: GS1 is the first accredited UDI issuing agency, with over 85% of products submitted to the FDA's GUDID platform using GS1 barcodes. The Drug Supply Chain Security Act (DSCSA) uses GS1 standards for pharmaceutical traceability.
- B. **EU EUDAMED**: GS1 is recognised for medical devices and pharmaceuticals under the EU Medical Device Regulation (MDR). Submissions to the EUDAMED platform require the GS1 Global Model Number as a product identifier.
- C. Malaysia: GS1 Standards and 2D Datamatrix is recognised as the official identification for pharmaceuticals & medical devices under the upcoming National Track & Trace System (MYMEDITRACE), to be implemented in 2030. - D. **China**: Medical device identification in China is mandated with GS1 unique identifiers. Manufacturers must register products with the National Medical Products Administration (NMPA).
- E. **South Korea & Saudi Arabia**: GS1 standards are used for medical product registration and traceability in both countries.
- F. **Other Countries:** GS1 standards are also being implemented in Australia, New Zealand, Singapore, India, and more.
